So..what is a wiki, anyway?

A wiki is a very simple collaborative database designed so that anyone with access can contribute or modify content. The word "wiki" is a Hawaiian word for "quick." Some users also refer to wikis as "What I Know Is." A wiki is not a carefully crafted site for casual visitors. Instead, it seeks to involve the visitor in an ongoing process of creation and collaboration.

What's PBWorks?


PBWorks is a private wiki hosting service that specalizes in business and academic wikis. PBWorks offers a sliding scale of wiki services, ranging from a basic free wiki to a more feature-rich academic version for \$100 a year.

Why PBWorks?

PBWorks is a very easy-to-use service that also comes with a lot of great features. While it is not a solution for everyone, it is a great option to consider particularly if you or your users are not the most tech-savvy. One of the most useful features is the ability to set different security statuses for individual pages or folders, and to give different levels of read-and-write access to individual users.
